Fruity, honey-like floral scents. Mineral taste with viscosity on the finish. Complex, elegant & finesse with a lengthy aftertaste.

Exuberant & pleasant nose full of ripe fruit, candied apricot & peach. Fresh, crisp & zesty. Well-balanced & harmonious.

(2nd Wine Ch Smith Haut Lafitte (Pessac-Léognan))

Nose of citrusy & pulpy fruits with honey characters. Fresh acidity & a creamy texture. Medium-bodied, fruity & balanced finishing with light.

Bouquet of berries, cassis & floral scents. Medium-bodied, fine tannins with well-defined acidity. A harmonious & long drawn out finish.

A robust wine with lovely fruits & a soft silky-textured finish. Well-balanced & rich.

**Ch Cos d'Estournel 2000 magnum 1.5L (2nd Growth) 3524
(St-Estephe)**

Spicy, smoky, leathery scents with dried fruits & floral notes. Medium-bodied with plush tannins & a lingering finish.

Ch La Fleur Petrus Pomerol 2006 (Pomerol) 1073

Floral & berries scents. Beautifully assimilated oak. Medium-bodied, firm & silky textured tannins. Complex, linear & a long finish.

Vieux Ch Certan Grand Vin Pomerol 2006 (Pomerol) 1196

Medium-bodied with supple tannins. Well-defined acidity. A smooth & sensual finish.

Ch Pavie-Decesse St-Emilion Grand Cru Classe 2010 (St-Emilion) 704

Medium-bodied with supple tannins & good acidity. Good acidity, blueberry & plum notes with cedar & minerals towards the finish.

Gaja Sito Moresco Langhe DOC 2020 (Piedmont) 177

Full-bodied, smooth ^ juicy with ripe red & black currants, herbs & spicy, smoky flavours.
Ell balance with silky tannins & good acidity. Very pleasant finish.

Gianni Gagliardo Barolo La Morra DOCG 2018 (Piedmont) 199

Soft, creamy textured with berry, nuts & chocolate. Polished tannins. Mid to full-bodied.
Approachable with a beautifully intense finish.

Gacci Rosso Rubicone IGT 2016 (Emilia-Romagna) 219

Smokey, oaky nose with dark berries. Palate is spicy with herbs, berries, cedar & tobacco.
Smooth & delicious tannins on a lingering finish.

Isole e Olena Cepparello 2018 (Tuscany) 253

Aromas of red fruit & cherries with a touch of spice.
Palate opens with ripe fruit & elegant tannins. A persistent finish.

USA CALIFORNIA

Au Bon Climat Knox Alexander Pinot Noir Sta Maria Valley 2020 (Santa Barbara County) 177

Bouquet of red cherries, plums & delicate spiced undertones.
Rich palate with fruit flavours & a touch of oak. Exquisite balance, fine-grained tannins & vivid acidity.

Duckhorn Merlot 2019 (Napa Valley) 149

Aromas of black raspberry, vanilla & liquorice. Red fruit flavours.
Smooth tannins & mid-level acidity. A lingering finish with hints of maple, cedar & spice.

Paul Hobbs Cabernet Sauvignon 2012 (Napa Valley) 1155

Red currant, boysenberry, cedar & herbs on the nose. Palate of herbs, berries & mineral.
Savoury, velvety tannins, harmony of richness & elegance ending in a long pure finish.

AUSTRALIA

Moss Wood Cabernet Sauvignon 2020 (Margaret River, WA) 185

Fresh fruit aromas of berries, currants, cherry plus floral scents. Soft oak notes, tobacco & tar.
Smooth, lengthy finish with savoury tannins & good acidity.

FRANCE: BORDEAUX

Mondot [Ch Troplong Mondot] 2018 (St-Emilion) 199

Vibrant fruit scents followed by blueberries, peppery notes & some earthiness. Medium to full-bodied, palate delivers fruit tones with rounded tannins.

No. 3 d'Angelus 2019 [Ch Angelus Premier Grand Cru Classe A] (St-Emilion) 189

Red berry fruit aromas & great freshness on the nose. Crisp, fresh fruit follows through on the palate with a balanced, taut & harmonious structure.

Fleur de Clinet [Ch Clinet] 2017 (Pomerol) 169

Scents of blackberries, liquorice & hint of earthiness. On the palate, fruit remains fresh & vibrant with fine & soft tannins. Notes of spices, plum & brown sugar bring intensity to the finish.

Ch Anseillan 2018 (Ch Lafite Rothschild 1st Growth) (Pauillac) 189

Intense expressive nose of cherry, smoky oak & spices. Well-balanced, voluminous, structured & fresh with a lengthy finish.

Pichon Comtesse Reserve 2018 (2nd wine Ch Pichon-Longueville Comtesse de Lalande 2nd Growth) (Pauillac) 149

Aromatic bouquet of ripe black fruits. Peppery & minty notes bring freshness. Fine tannins, elegant & refined structure stretches long into the finish.

Pastourelle de Clerc Milon Pauillac 2017 (2nd wine Ch Clerc Milon 5th Growth) (Pauillac) 139

Nose of potpourri, cinnamon & berry fruits. Mid to full-bodied with light tannins. Intense fruit with firm texture & fresh finishing long.

Lacoste Borie Pauillac 2018 (2nd wine Ch Grand-Puy-Lacoste 5th Growth) (Pauillac) 159

Stewed fruits with some earthiness, herbs & spices. Soft, juicy & approachable with ripe tannins & fleshy black fruit. Elegant & refined.

Baron de Brane Margaux 2018 (2nd wine Ch Brane-Cantenac 2nd Growth) (Margaux) 149

Spicy, fruity, floral. Medium-bodied, soft & elegant with red berry charms. Lovely acidity & supple tannins.

 Nose of roses, red fruits & earth. Juicy, crisp & fresh with savouriness. Full-body with beautiful layers of ripe fruits & creamy tannins. Impressively well-balanced.
- La Dame de Montrose 2014 (St - Estephe)** **179**
 Floral with attractive peppery notes. Elegant with good depth & excellent balance of ripeness & fresh dry tannins & acidity. Long, clean finish.
- Les Hauts de Smith Rouge 2017 (2nd Wine Ch Smith Haut Lafitte Cru Classe Graves) (Pessac-Leognan)** **143**
 Ripe red & black fruits with a hint of spice & vanilla. Smooth fresh palate. Overall mouthfeel of balance & harmony with polished & textured tannins.

 Juicy ripe berries & rich cacao beans. Bold & expressive. Elegant & well-balanced complemented by spicy & mineral notes.

 Richly structured, generous & full of black fruits. Matured with tannins still in place. Good freshness & an excellent finish.

 Aromatic, rich & concentrated. Gentle extraction of tannins. Elegant, finely structured & well balanced.

Firm yet balanced with accents of earth & tobacco on the long finish.

Concerto di Fonterutoli IGT Toscana 2018 (Chianti Classico) 199

Notes of cherry & fragrant wood, cigar box & hint of earthiness in the background.
Rich, juicy, compact & dense. Well-integrated woody notes, vigorous & a lengthy finish.

LIBRARY COLLECTION

From time to time, Que Pasa is lucky enough to come across winemakers who understand why we are in the wine business - we truly love and enjoy wine.

We believe that is what has prompted them to release to us limited amounts of fine, rare wines from their 'library collections. Stocks of wines which are cellared away by wine houses for private consumption or for special occasions to be shared by friends of the wineries.



CHATEAU de BEAUCASTEL Châteauneuf-du-Pape (Rhone, FRANCE)

In 1321, under Pope Jean XXII, four barrels were brought from the papal cellars to be filled with wine in Chateauneuf. Then, the Popes planted new vines & the legend of the papal wine began.

The first evidence of Chateau de Beaucastel as it exists today was in the sixteenth century. In 1549, Pierre de Beaucastel bought a barn with a plot of land extending to 52 saumees at Coudoulet. The manor house will be built then with the arms of Beaucastel sculptured on a stone wall of the drawing room.

In 1909, Pierre Tramier leads the wine estate & then transfers it to his son-in-law, Pierre Perrin, a scientist that developed Beaucastel. Then Jaccques Perrin continued his father's efforts until 1978.

Today, the torch is being carried by Jean-Pierre & Francois, Jacques Perrin's sons. The 5th generation, Marc, Pierre, Thomas, Cecile, Charles, Matthieu & Cesar, work all together with them.

Beaucastel, is first of all, a family story, the story of Famile Perrin. Their main strength is being able to blend the talents of each family member to run the estate under common values., absolut respect for land & terrorir, biodynamic culture as a philosophy of life, the research of truth, balance & elegance.

CHATEAU MUSAR (BEKAA VALLEY, LEBANON)

In 1930, at just 20 years old, Gaston Hochar founded Chateau Musar, inspired by Lebanon's 6,000 year winemaking tradition and his travels in Bordeaux. His 'wines with noblesse' greatly impressed senior officers in the army following on from the French mandate of the 1920s. Major Ronald Barton, of Chateau Langoa-Barton, stationed in Lebanon during World War II became a great friend, strengthening the links between Chateau Musar and Bordeaux that remain to this day. (Bekaa Valley, Lebanon)

Serge Hochar, Gaston's eldest son trained as a civil engineer, then decided to study oenology and with the encouragement of his father became a student of Emile Peynaud at the University of Oenology in Bordeaux. Having declared to his father "I want to make the wine my way, I want it to be known world-wide and I want you to quit!" he became Chateau Musar winemaker in 1959, Gaston senior having graciously given way. He then spent 18 years perfecting the formula for Chateau Musar's Red and was chosen as Decanter Magazine's first 'Man of the Year' in 1984 for his dedication to producing superb quality wines during Lebanon's Civil War (1975-1990).

Chateau Musar Red 1998 **187**

Medium dark red violet colour. Aromatic with gorgeous berries, cherries & herbs plus hints of earthiness & leather. Silky textured with mid-level acidity, well-balanced & a medium plus finish.

Chateau Musar Red 2017 **169**

Berries, cherries & plum on the nose with hints of tea & liquorice. Well-integrated, soft tannins, good acidity, depth of fruit & a lengthy finish.

Ch Musar Levantine de Musar 2021 **143**

Floral notes, berries, plum, tobacco & cherries. Richly fruited with soft tannins & fresh acidity. Elegant, subtle texture with complexity & a great length.

Chateau Musar Blanc 2015 **163**

Very aromatic juice and turned into a fruity, fresh wine with citrus leaves, peaches and pears. Fermented in oak barriques with a longer maturation period and had a complexity of fruits and aromas. The final wine is beautifully balanced with good fresh lemon acidity, tropical fruit flavors and an elegant finish.



TORRES

Founded in 1870 by Jaime Torres, Bodegas Torres (Miguel Torres SA) is a historical wine growing company located in Pals, some 4 km from Vilafranca del Penedès, where the company has its head office. Torres is the family winery with the most extensive vineyards in the Denomination of Origin (DO) of Penedès and the largest winery in Spain.

Milmanda 1000 Years of History

DO Conca de Barberà

Years of patient research have resulted in Milmanda. The complete and harmonious combination of aromas of this elegant, noble wine elevate it to truly world-class status.

Milmanda was part of a route of medieval castles that gave shelter to Christians during the time of the Reconquest. In the 12th century peace came to these lands and vine-growing began anew. Today, at the foot of these castle walls, the Torres family grows the Chardonnay grape variety. This single vineyard wine is fermented and aged in French oak barrels.

MAS La Plana Legend in Black DO Penedès

In this small (29 ha.) vineyard only the most select Cabernet Sauvignon grapes are grown. These are used to make strictly limited quantities of Torres' most prestigious red wine, now known to connoisseurs all over the world. In the Paris Wine Olympiad, the 1970 vintage triumphed over some of the most famous wines in the world, including some of the best from Bordeaux. This success has been repeated on several other occasions, with Gran Coronas Mas La Plana notching up numerous other international awards.

Reserva Real *Limited Reserve* DO Penedès

Reserva Real was created after his majesty King Don Juan Carlos visited our winery in 1995 and was treated to one of the most exclusive and limited production wines in Spain.

It is created from the best Cabernet Sauvignon, Cabernet Franc and Merlot grapes from our small vineyard Agulladolç, which is also home to a beautiful 11th century Romanesque hermitage. After 18 months in new French oak barrels, and thanks to the great quality of the tannins in this wine.

Very dark cassis and mineral notes on the nose - very suave and refined; fine tannins and structure on the palate, ample concentration but at this age very mellow and silky.
