#### FRANCE

**Henri Bourgeois Pouilly Fume "La Demosielle" 2019 (Loire) 147**

Rich & elegant with texture & finesse. Long aftertaste with floral notes dominating.

**S de Suduiraut Blanc Sec 2015 (dry white) [Sauternes] 139**

Vanilla, spices, floral & citrus scents. Powerful, good acidity, some minerality & a beautiful long finish.

**Yves Cuilleron Condrieu La Petite Cote 2019 (Rhône) 167**

Exuberant & pleasant nose full of ripe fruit, candied apricots & peach.  
Honey & citrus zest. Lemony freshness, crisp, balanced & harmonious.

**Les Hauts de Smith Blanc 2019 169**  
**(2nd Wine Ch Smith Haut Lafitte (Pessac-Léognan))**

Pale yellow colour with fresh citrus notes on the nose plus mango, pear & honey characters.  
Palate of fresh acidity & creamy texture. A medium-bodied wine, fruity & balance.  
Finishing with a light mineral touch.

**Hugel Gewurztraminer Selection de Grains Noble 317**  
**1988 (Alsace)**

Excellent nose of botrytised grapes with apricot jam, candied fruit & floral aromas. Rich & intense.  
Brilliant concentration of fruit & spice flavours in a seemingly endless finish.

#### CALIFORNIA, USA

**Marimar Torres Chardonnay Don Miguel 137**  
**Vineyards 2019 (Russian River)**

Elegant nose of ripe fruits with hint of almond & toasted oak. Medium-bodied with a spicy finish.

**Antica A26 Chardonnay 2016 (Napa Valley) 147**

Rich & intense with aromas of apricot & peach along with minerality.  
Fresh with vibrant acidity ending in a lingering finish.

**AUSTRALIA**

**Pierro Chardonnay 2020 (Margaret River) 165**

Subtle, restrained & delicate with peach & nectarine flavours.  
Wonderful mouthfeel, unctuous with lingering tangy acidity.  
Fresh, vibrant, balanced & well-integrated.

**Adega Algueira Pizarra 2015 (Ribeira Sacra) 143**

A ripe & generously oaked Mencia without it being over powering.  
Perfume & floral characters with dusty tannins & medium-bodied.

**Hacienda Monasterio Ribera del Duero DOC 2019 (Ribera del Duero) 179**

Berry fruits, cassis & minerality with liquorice & floral notes.  
Concentrated & flavoursome. Ripe fruit characters.  
Well integrated oak with firm tannins. Long lingering finish.

**Bodegas Mauro Mauro VS 2019 (Ribera del Duero) **NEW** 217**

Succulent & fresh with red fruit aromas. Complex & deep, juicy with harmonious tannins.  
Great mouthfeel, balance & a lingering finish.

**CVNE Imperial Gran Reserva (Rioja) **NEW** 187**

Nose of red & dark berries, hint of tobacco & spice scents.  
Rich & dense with savoury tannins with depth & concentration.

**FRANCE BURGUNDY**

**Lucien Boillot Pommard 1er Cru Les Fremiers 2018 (Côte de Beaune) 247**

Succulent dark berry fruits & floral aromas with slight herbal flavours.  
Silky, soft tannins. Excellent depth & concentration.

**Bouchard Grand Vin de Beaune-Greves** 299  
**Vigne de L'Enfant Jesus 2018 (Beaune)**

Expressive fruity & spicy notes with woody fragrances. Intense, delicate & silky feel on the palate.

## **BORDEAUX**

**Ch Pichon Longueville Comtesse de Lalande 2002** 660  
**(2nd Growth) (Pauillac)**

Fruity, earthy & floral aromas. Silky tannins & a long, refined finish.

**Ch Pichon Longueville Comtesse de Lalande 2006** 956  
**(2nd Growth) (Pauillac)**

Bouquet of berries, cassis & floral scents. Medium-bodied, fine tannins with well-defined acidity. A harmonious & long drawn out finish.

**Ch d'Issan 2010 (3rd Growth) (Margaux)** 443

Aromatics of flowers, berries, liquorice, cedar & hazelnut. Medium to full body. Well-balanced with length.

**Ch Palmer 2006 (3rd Growth) (Margaux)** 915

A robust wine with lovely fruits & a soft silky-textured finish. Well-balanced & rich.

**Ch Ormez de Pez 2018 (St-Estephe)** 139

Dense & lively with berries characters. Full-body with powerful tannins. A velvety texture finishing long.

**Ch Cos d'Estournel 2000 (2nd Growth) (St-Estephe)** 3524  
**magnum 1.5L**

Spicy, smoky, leathery scents with dried fruits & floral notes. Medium-bodied with plush tannins & a lingering finish.

**Ch Gloria 2018 (St-Julien)** 189

Rich & fresh with ripe tannins. A medium to full body wine with a beautifully balanced & elegant mouthfeel.

**Ch Talbot St-Julien Grand Cru Classe 2018 (St-Julien)** 243

Cherry, cassis & blueberry fruit notes. Smooth & juicy on the palate. Ripe tannins & balanced acidity. Rich, powerful & rich, yet elegant with a beautiful finish.

**Ch La Fleur Petrus Pomerol 2006 (Pomerol) 1073**

Floral & berries scents. Beautifully assimilated oak. Medium-bodied, firm & silky textured tannins. Complex, linear & a long finish.

**Vieux Ch Certan Grand Vin Pomerol 2006 (Pomerol) 1196**

Medium-bodied with supple tannins. Well-defined acidity. A smooth & sensual finish.

**Ch Pavie-Decesse St-Emilion Grand Cru Classe 2010 (St-Emilion) 704**

Medium-bodied with supple tannins & good acidity. Good acidity, blueberry & plum notes with cedar & minerals towards the finish.

**ITALY**

**Gaja Sito Moresco Langhe DOC 2020 (Piedmont) 159**

Full-bodied, smooth ^ juicy with ripe red & black currants, herbs & spicy, smoky flavours. Ell balance with silky tannins & good acidity. Very pleasant finish.

**Isole e Olena Cepparello 2018 (Tuscany) 253**

Aromas of red fruit & cherries with a touch of spice. Palate opens with ripe fruit & elegant tannins. A persistent finish.

## USA CALIFORNIA

**Au Bon Climat Pinot Noir Lala Panzi Vineyard Russian River Valley 2018 (Sonoma County)** **NEW** 177

Berry fruits character, spice aromas & flavours. Well-balanced vanillin note, medium acidity, integrated tannins. A flavourful fruit finish.

**Duckhorn Merlot 2019 (Napa Valley)** 149

Aromas of black raspberry, vanilla & liquorice. Red fruit flavours. Smooth tannins & mid-level acidity. A lingering finish with hints of maple, cedar & spice

**Opus One 2015 (Napa Valley)** 893

Nose of cassis, black fruits & flowers & spice. Firm tannins & full-bodied. Great acidity with dark raspberries, minerality & tobacco. A long lingering finish.

**Paul Hobbs Cabernet Sauvignon 2012 (Napa Valley)** 1155

Red currant, boysenberry, cedar & herbs on the nose. Palate of herbs, berries & mineral. Savoury, velvety tannins, harmony of richness & elegance ending in a long pure finish.

## AUSTRALIA

**Moss Wood Cabernet Sauvignon 2020 (Margaret River, WA)** 185

Fresh fruit aromas of berries, currants, cherry plus floral scents. Soft oak notes, tobacco & tar. Smooth, lengthy finish with savoury tannins & good acidity.

### **FRANCE: BORDEAUX**

**Ch Anseillan (Ch Lafite Rothschild 1st Growth 2018)  
(Pauillac) 189**

Intense expressive nose of cherry, smoky oak & spices. Well-balanced, voluminous, structured & fresh with a lengthy finish.

**Blason d'Issan 2015 (Ch d'Issan 3rd Growth Margaux) 149**

Nose of blackberry, cassis, earth & spice. Unforgettable supple & textured upfront appeal. Smooth tannins, good acidity & a lingering aftertaste.

**Pavillon de Leoville Poyferre 2017 167  
(Ch Leoville Poyferre 2nd Growth St-Julien)**

Nose of roses, red fruits & earth. Juicy, crisp & fresh with savouriness. Full-body with beautiful layers of ripe fruits & creamy tannins. Impressively well-balanced.

**Clos du Marquis 2013 237  
(Ch leoville Las Cases 2nd Growth St-Julien)**

Currants, blackberries with hint of earthiness on the nose. Structured & concentrated with velvety tannins ending in a long, flavourful finish.

**Les Hauts de Smith Rouge 2016 137  
(Ch Smith Haut Lafitte Graves Cru Classe Pessac-Leognan)**

Ripe red & black fruits with a hint of spice & vanilla. Smooth fresh palate. Overall mouthfeel of balance & harmony with polished & textured tannins.

**Petit-Figeac 2016** 187  
**(Ch Figeac Premier Grand Cru Classe A St-Emilion)**

Intense scents of plums, berries, spices & potpourri. Bright, elegant with hint of minerality. Vibrant & fresh on the finish.

**Chapelle d'Ausone 2007** 547  
**(Ch Ausone Premier Grand Cru Classe A St-Emilion)**

Delicious & crisp with minerality along with berry & cherry characteristics. Supple texture & fruit flavours. Medium body, fine tannins & a caressing finish.

**ITALY**

**Tenuta San Guido Guidalberto 2020 [Sassicaia Bolgheri]** 159

A lean, athletic style offering black cherry, plum & spice flavours. Firm yet balanced with accents of earth & tobacco on the long finish.

**Concerto di Fonterutoli IGT Toscana 2018** **NEW** 199  
**(Chianti Classico)**

Notes of cherry & fragrant wood, cigar box & hint of earthiness in the background. Rich, juicy, compact & dense. Well-integrated woody notes, vigorous & a lengthy finish.



## ***LIBRARY COLLECTION***

From time to time, Que Pasa is lucky enough to come across winemakers who understand why we are in the wine business - we truly love and enjoy wine.

We believe that is what has prompted them to release to us limited amounts of fine, rare wines from their 'library collections. Stocks of wines which are cellared away by wine houses for private consumption or for special occasions to be shared by friends of the wineries.



### **CHATEAU de BEAUCASTEL Châteauneuf-du-Pape (Rhone, FRANCE)**

In 1321, under Pope Jean XXII, four barrels were brought from the papal cellars to be filled with wine in Chateauneuf. Then, the Popes planted new vines & the legend of the papal wine began.

The first evidence of Chateau de Beaucastel as it exists today was in the sixteenth century. In 1549, Pierre de Beaucastel bought a barn with a plot of land extending to 52 saumees at Coudoulet. The manor house will be built then with the arms of Beaucastel sculptured on a stone wall of the drawing room.

In 1909, Pierre Tramier leads the wine estate & then transfers it to his son-in-law, Pierre Perrin, a scientist that developed Beaucastel. Then Jaccques Perrin continued his father's efforts until 1978.

Today, the torch is being carried by Jean-Pierre & Francois, Jacques Perrin's sons. The 5th generation, Marc, Pierre, Thomas, Cecile, Charles, Matthieu & Cesar, work all together with them.

Beaucastel, is first of all, a family story, the story of Famile Perrin. Their main strength is being able to blend the talents of each family member to run the estate under common values., absolut respect for land & terrorir, biodynamic culture as a philosophy of life, the research of truth, balance & elegance.

Aromatics of berry & flowers. Deep, penetrating & alluringly fruity. Juicy acidity, concentrated yet lively finishing long.	
<b>Chateauneuf-du-Pape Blanc 2019</b>	<b>273</b>
Bouquet of honeyed citrus, flowers & a touch of flinty mineral. Balanced, well-integrated acidity & a great, mineral finish.	
<b>Chateauneuf-du-Pape Blanc 2020</b>	<b>273</b>
Full-bodied with good acidity running through. Powerful, balanced & textured with good length.	



## **CHATEAU MUSAR (BEKAA VALLEY, LEBANON)**

In 1930, at just 20 years old, Gaston Hochar founded Chateau Musar, inspired by Lebanon's 6,000 year winemaking tradition and his travels in Bordeaux. His 'wines with noblesse' greatly impressed senior officers in the army following on from the French mandate of the 1920s. Major Ronald Barton, of Chateau Langoa-Barton, stationed in Lebanon during World War II became a great friend, strengthening the links between Chateau Musar and Bordeaux that remain to this day. (Bekaa Valley, Lebanon)

Serge Hochar, Gaston's eldest son trained as a civil engineer, then decided to study oenology and with the encouragement of his father became a student of Emile Peynaud at the University of Oenology in Bordeaux. Having declared to his father "I want to make the wine my way, I want it to be known world-wide and I want you to quit!" he became Chateau Musar winemaker in 1959, Gaston senior having graciously given way. He then spent 18 years perfecting the formula for Chateau Musar's Red and was chosen as Decanter Magazine's first 'Man of the Year' in 1984 for his dedication to producing superb quality wines during Lebanon's Civil War (1975-1990).

### **Chateau Musar Red 1998**

**187**

Medium dark red violet colour. Aromatic with gorgeous berries, cherries & herbs plus hints of earthiness & leather. Silky textured with mid-level acidity, well-balanced & a medium plus finish.

### **Chateau Musar Red 2015 / 2016**

**169**

Floral, spices & red fruits with tobacco & leather on the nose. High acidity, medium tannins with well-integrated oak & solid fruits. Powerful finish that lingers.

### **Chateau Musar Blanc 2014**

**163**

Very aromatic juice and turned into a fruity, fresh wine with citrus leaves, peaches and pears. Fermented in oak barriques with a longer maturation period and had a complexity of fruits and aromas. The final wine is beautifully balanced with good fresh lemon acidity, tropical fruit flavors and an elegant finish.



## TORRES

Founded in 1870 by Jaime Torres, Bodegas Torres (Miguel Torres SA) is a historical wine growing company located in Pals, some 4 km from Vilafranca del Penedès, where the company has its head office. Torres is the family winery with the most extensive vineyards in the Denomination of Origin (DO) of Penedès and the largest winery in Spain.

### Milmanda 1000 Years of History

#### DO Conca de Barberà

Years of patient research have resulted in Milmanda. The complete and harmonious combination of aromas of this elegant, noble wine elevate it to truly world-class status.

Milmanda was part of a route of medieval castles that gave shelter to Christians during the time of the Reconquest. In the 12th century peace came to these lands and vine-growing began anew. Today, at the foot of these castle walls, the Torres family grows the Chardonnay grape variety. This single vineyard wine is fermented and aged in French oak barrels.

### MAS La Plana Legend in Black DO Penedès

In this small (29 ha.) vineyard only the most select Cabernet Sauvignon grapes are grown. These are used to make strictly limited quantities of Torres' most prestigious red wine, now known to connoisseurs all over the world. In the Paris Wine Olympiad, the 1970 vintage triumphed over some of the most famous wines in the world, including some of the best from Bordeaux. This success has been repeated on several other occasions, with Gran Coronas Mas La Plana notching up numerous other international awards.

## **Reserva Real *Limited Reserve* DO Penedès**

Reserva Real was created after his majesty King Don Juan Carlos visited our winery in 1995 and was treated to one of the most exclusive and limited production wines in Spain.

It is created from the best Cabernet Sauvignon, Cabernet Franc and Merlot grapes from our small vineyard Agulladolç, which is also home to a beautiful 11th century Romanesque hermitage. After 18 months in new French oak barrels, and thanks to the great quality of the tannins in this wine.

Very dark cassis and mineral notes on the nose - very suave and refined; fine tannins and structure on the palate, ample concentration but at this age very mellow and silky.
